ZRP receives two more buses from His Excellency, President Mnangagwa

Zimbabwe Republic Police is set for good times ahead in terms of transport after His Excellency, President Emmerson Dambudzo Mnangagwa recently handed over two more 65-seater Golden Dragon buses to the organisation.

The Commissioner General Tandabantu Godwin Matanga received the buses which are meant to cushion the transport challenges bedevilling the organisation.

President Mnangagwa said his administration would continue to respond to needs of Government workers in order to motivate them and improve on service delivery.

"A country is built by its citizenry and this is how we are building it. As Government, we have purchased these buses for our security services and other departments. We are expecting another batch of over 500 buses some of which will be given to all our security services as well as various government institutions until they get adequate transport," he said.

The Chief Staff Officer [Transport and Logistics] at Police General Headquarters, Commissioner Gift Hlabiso expressed gratitude to the President for the donation of buses.

"We are indeed grateful to His Excellency, President Emmerson Dambudzo Mnangagwa for

giving us two additional buses. Such a gesture proves beyond doubt that the Head of State is a listening President who gives an ear to our concerns. The two buses donated to the ZRP will surely go a long way in alleviating transport challenges for members of the police service", said Commissioner Hlabiso.

Apart from the ZRP, other institutions that also received buses include the Zimbabwe Prisons and Correctional Service, Zimbabwe National Army, Airforce of Zimbabwe, Judicial Service Commission and the Parliament of Zimbabwe.

To date, the ZRP has received a total of three buses from the President.
